

Third proposal:

1. MARINA KAŠTELA – MASLINICA, Island of Šolta - Muna bay

Protected from the winds.



Fishermen village located in natural bay facing S-W side of the world with unbelievable view on seven islands. Near to the centre there is the four storey fortress with loop holes built at the end of the 17th century, beside which later on baroque castle was built (today the hotel).

2. MASLINICA, Island of Šolta - Muna bay, ISLAND OF ŽIRJE

Exposed to N wind



Island of Žirje is the largest of all the islands in the Sibenik archipelago. Žirje is also the only place on the island and it is connected to Muna bay with the road. Beside Muna bay, there is also Vela Stupica bay to anchorage.

3. ISLAND OF ŽIRJE – ISLAND OF PIŠKERA

Partly exposed to SE and NW winds and waves, good protected from north wind bura.



Between island of Piskera and island of Panitula Vela there is Marina Piškera. This is second largest island in NP Kornati. Piskera used to be inhabited in the past, but there are two restaurants.

4. ISLAND OF PIŠKERA – SKRADIN

Good protected from the winds.



Estuary of river Krka is the mouth of the river that flows into the sea and it is navigable up to town of Skradin. From Skradin it is possible to walk to NP Krka, Skradinski buk – seventh longest and the most beautiful waterfall on the Krka River. Sightseeing at Skradinski Buk is possible, owing to a network of paths and bridges that permits pleasant and safe walking. Entrance Fee is applicable, price list can be found:

5. SKRADIN – PRIMOŠTEN

Exposed to SW wind.



Typical small dalmatian place offering pleasant walks in the shade of pine trees, bars and restaurants. Old centre is situated on small peninsula which used to be an island. Pebble beaches are also found directly in the place.

6. PRIMOŠTEN – TROGIR

Exposed to W and NW winds



Centre of Trogir is situated on small island which does not exceed 750 steps and lies between mainland and island of Čiovo. City is surrounded with towers and walls (on the parts) and is rich with cultural monuments (among them also famous St. John's Cathedral). The whole city centre is under protection of UNESCO. Marina is situated opposite of the centre on island of Čiovo – in the channel of Trogir, between Trogir bridge and cape of Čubrijan. For the yachts it is only possible to approach from the west, between Island of Čiovo and Čelice reef.
